The conference

Join us for edifying Bible teaching, worship times, and the chance to intercede together on behalf of the nation and the church. There are 4 sessions each day, with plenty of time in between for fellowship with others and quiet time to yourself. Everyone is welcome, whether a member of IFB or not. The week will be led by IFB co-directors Josh MacDonald and Ashley Thompson.

The venue

Cloverley Hall is a Christian conference centre in a former Victorian country house, with 9 acres of private grounds and surrounded by farmlands. It has a wide range of facilities, including a heated indoor pool, games room, tennis courts, football pitch, French boules, and a range of walks. We expect to have sole use of the centre and all its facilities. The nearest train station (Whitchurch) is a 10-minute taxi ride away.

Family-friendly

While others are welcome as usual, we also want families to be able to attend. Families will be significantly subsidised to help with the cost; family bedrooms are available, and separate childcare/Bible activities will be provided by a mixture of parents and other volunteers (aiming for no-one to be on the rota for more than ¼ of the main sessions). As well as the facilities described above, there is a creche room with a range of toys, and an outdoor play area.

Rooms

Given its historic nature, Cloverley Hall has a wide variety of bedrooms. Most family rooms are en-suite; the majority of smaller rooms have a shared bathroom, but have their own sinks. En-suite rooms and single rooms will be allocated based on need, and are first come first served. Most rooms are on the first floor (with no lift); three downstairs rooms are available for those with limited mobility (sharing a disabled bathroom).



Cost (for three nights)

£232 adult; £170 adult concession*; family with children £350**

*Optional lower rate for those with limited financial resources (who would otherwise find it hard to come because of the cost).

** Flat rate for families (however many children), thanks to members' donations.

If financial concerns are still an issue, whether as an individual or a family, please tell us what you can pay, and we will try to support you so you can still come. A shorter stay may also be possible.

Final payment is required by 30th June.
